

Registration Appointments for the Class of 2023

The purpose of the registration appointment is to enroll eighth grade students in their 2019-2020 North High freshman courses.

Parents will receive their appointment time in the freshman registration packet mailed to each student's home by the second week of January.

Eighth grade registration appointments will be one-on-one: counselor, parent and student. All appointments will take place in the North High Cafeteria between 8:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. on Saturday, February 2, 2019.

Parents will be asked to verify any demographic (address, phone, email, etc.) information before proceeding to their counselor appointment. In addition, a flyer was included in the January registration packet informing parents that if there is a change of address, they must provide required documentation in order to update their address and proceed to their appointment.

Counselor appointments will be 5-7 minutes in length. Students will also take their freshman ID photo and have the opportunity to purchase Trojan Spirit Wear.

Please assist us, whenever possible, to communicate the following information to families:

- **The sole purpose of this registration appointment is to enroll the student for his or her 2019-2020 courses. Given that we want to extend equal opportunities to all families, counselors will not discuss other issues during registration.**
- **Families who do not agree with the assigned course recommendations will be advised to contact their middle school faculty or the North High Department Chair.**
- **Families are encouraged to set up a separate meeting with their counselor to discuss transition issues.**
- **It is important that families keep their scheduled appointment and arrive on time.**

Special Services students will be registered for courses during individual transition staffings in January and February at their school. However, they are invited to the Saturday registration event to take their ID photo and purchase Trojan Spirit Wear.
